WSMS, as part of a Pan Sussex Mediation Alliance, has received a grant from the 'Safer in Sussex Community Fund' which is an initiative of the Sussex Police & Crime Commissioner, Katy Bourne. The four Alliance members will use the funding to service referrals made by Police staff across East and West Sussex, in support of the priorities of the Police and Crime Plan.

Over 60 local organisations have been awarded grants totalling almost £300,000 from the Fund.

Referrals

We finished June with 27 referrals covering a diverse list of topics including children, pets, verbal abuse, noise, harassment, boundary, garden, hedge, parking, shared space, building work, antisocial behaviour and family. That was our second busiest June on record.



The total referrals for the 1st quarter were 83 against a total of 57 in 2013, a fair increase. A snapshot on 8th July showed 23 mediators on the board assigned to current or pending cases.
