Diane is away 23rd - 26th October and 30th November —4th December.


Kind Thought

Tempest

Brighton and Hove Independent Mediation Service (BHIMS) has made a short film. It highlights the impact of neighbourhood disputes, breakdowns in communication, loneliness and social exclusion. They will be using the film to raise awareness of the value of mediation and to help in recruitment.

'Tempest' was directed by a BHIMS mediator and film maker, Justin Spray. It was made in collaboration with Brighton and Hove Council and Sussex Police and was made possible following a grant from the Sussex Community Foundation. Professional actors played the role of clients and several BHIMS mediators were involved. Tempest has been submitted into the Brighton Short Film Festival and for a National Mediation Award.

WSMS have been extended an invitation to attend the premiere, which is being held during National Mediation Week. The event is also being used as a recruitment drive by BHMS aimed at young people interested in training as mediators. Following the film viewing there will be a Q & A session with both actors and crew. BHIMS mediators will also be available to talk about our service and explain what is involved in becoming a mediator.

Nick, our Co-ordinator will be away at the time so the offer is extended to others within the organisation or beyound. If you would like to attend, the office can RSVP on your behalf and collate interest. We must reply by 24th September.

The premiere will take place on **Thursday October 11th** at Sallis Benney Theatre, Brighton — Reception from 6.30pm with film being shown at 7pm.


